



# Hill House Fall In-house Soccer 2010

## Overall Program Philosophy

*Hill House is committed to providing a safe, fun, and educational environment to ensure that all players have the best possible experience playing soccer. We are committed to teaching our players not only the game of soccer, but also the importance of teamwork, sportsmanship, and leadership. Our volunteer coaches must understand our philosophy and recognize their importance in the individual development of each player.*

## Season Overview

Over 300 children participate in Hill House's Fall In-house Soccer League. The season commences on Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup> with the annual Soccer Jamboree and ends on Saturday, November 20<sup>th</sup> with the annual season ending Teddy's Tournament. During the ten week season, teams practice once a week and play a game on Saturday mornings. (No soccer on Saturday, October 9<sup>th</sup> due to the Columbus Day holiday)

## Age Groups

### U6 Division (co-ed)

*Teams:* Comprised of 8-10 players each with two coaches. Games are played as 6 v 6. (40 minute games)

*Practices:* Tuesdays from 5:15-6:15pm      *Games:* Saturdays at 8:45, 9:45, or 10:45am

### U8 Girls & Boys Divisions

*Teams:* Comprised of 9-11 players each with two coaches. Games are played as 7 v 7. (50 minute games)

*Practices:* Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30pm      *Games:* Girls - 9:00 or 10:30am; Boys - 8:45, 9:45, or 10:45am

### U12 Girls & Boys Divisions

*Teams:* Comprised of 10-12 players each with two coaches. Games are played as 8 v 8. (60 minute games)

*Practices:* Thursdays from 5:30-6:30pm      *Games:* Girls - 9:00 or 10:30am; Boys - 9:00 or 10:30am

## Coaching

Coaches are vital to the success of the soccer league. Interested coaches should complete an application and fill out CORI and SORI forms as required by the state of Massachusetts. Coaches must attend training session(s) as well as their team's practices and games throughout the season. Coaches should enjoy working with children and have basic knowledge of soccer. Hill House staff members provide support and assistance to coaches throughout the season.

## Soccer Jamboree – Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup> from 9:00am-12:00pm

At the annual opening day of the soccer season, players pick up their uniforms, meet their teammates and coaches, and participate in fun soccer activities and drills.

## Teddy's Tournament – Saturday, November 20<sup>th</sup> (Tournament game schedule and rules TBA)

The U8 and U12 divisions participate in an exciting, all day tournament to determine the age group champions.

Hill House staff makes all decisions regarding the canceling of practices and games due to inclement weather. All families and coaches will be notified of any cancellation via e-mail. If Saturday games are canceled, participants and coaches will receive an automated call by 7:30 AM. Weekday practices will be canceled by 4:00 PM. Please be advised that the law only permits the public to receive information on sex offenders required to register and finally classified by the Board as a level 2 (moderate risk) or level 3 (high risk) offender. Therefore, information is not available to the public if the identified individual is a level 1 (low risk) offender or if he/she has not yet been finally classified by the Board.

All requests shall be recorded and kept confidential, except to assist or defend in a criminal prosecution.
